



Medicaid Cuts, Hospital Closures and the Impact on West Virginia Communities

The “Big, Beautiful Bill” – or **#CapitoCare** – cuts **\$1.1 Trillion** from **Medicaid** and the **ACA** to pay for handouts to the wealthiest Americans and corporations.

522,000 WV Children and Adults are enrolled in Medicaid

82,225 Children & Adults will **lose coverage**

165,000 West Virginians are covered by Medicaid expansion thanks to the ACA

114,225 working adults will **lose coverage**

TOTAL LOSS: **196,450** West Virginians expected to **lose Medicaid** coverage thanks to **#CapitoCare**


