522,000 children and adults are enrolled in West Virginia Medicaid

Among all Medicaid enrollees in West Virginia:

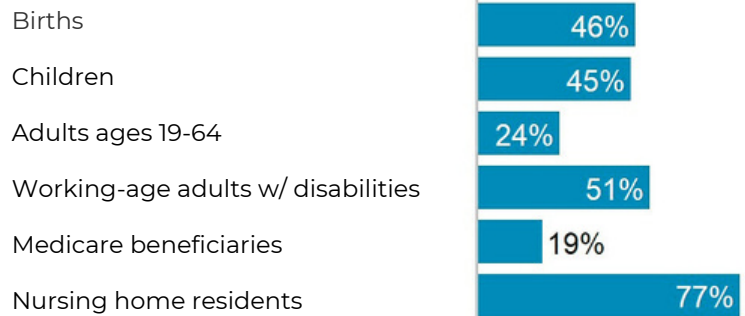
3 in 10 (32%) are children
1 in 5 (20%) have three or more chronic conditions

3 in 10 (34%) live in a rural area

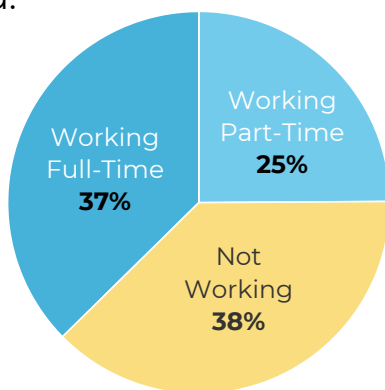
WV expansion status: **✓ Adopted**

In West Virginia, Medicaid covers...



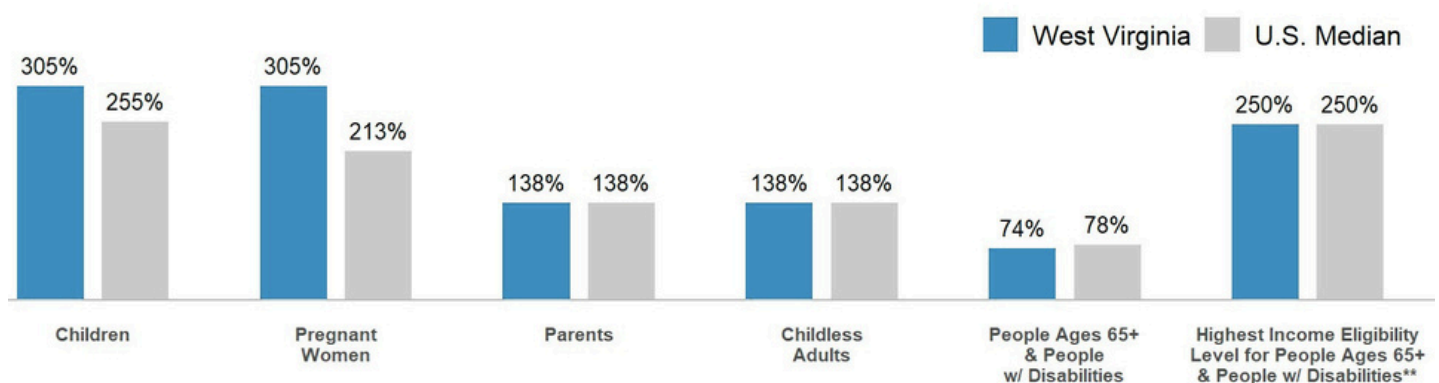
A majority (**62%**) of West Virginia adults enrolled in Medicaid are employed.



Medicaid covers from 25% to 35% of people in WV's congressional districts



Medicaid eligibility limits as a percent of the federal poverty level (FPL)*

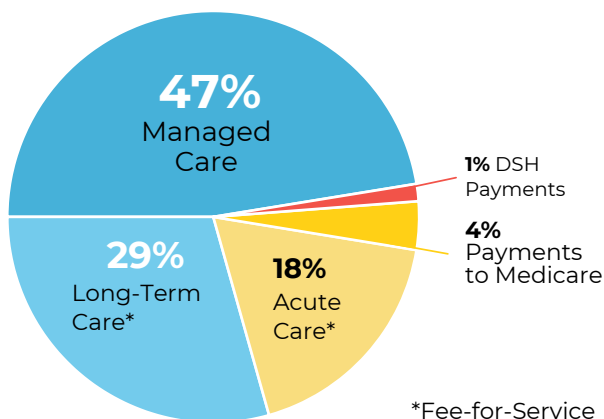


*The FPL in 2025 is \$26,650 for a family of three and \$15,650 for an individual.

**To qualify for Medicaid at the higher income eligibility levels, individuals must meet requirements for the buy-in program for working age people with disabilities.

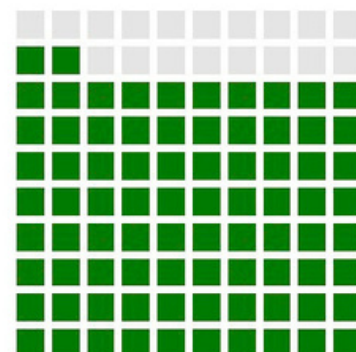


Total Medicaid spending in West Virginia is **\$5.5 billion**

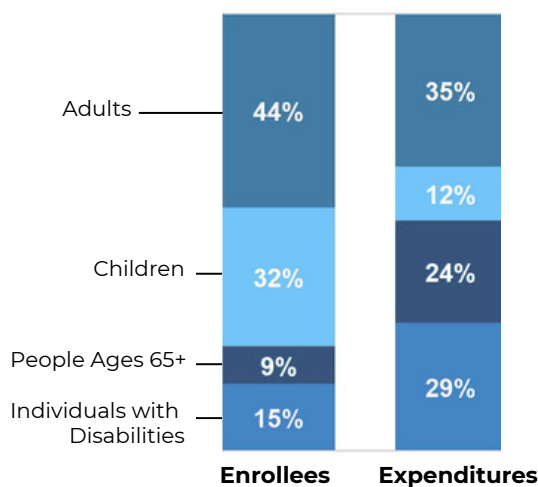


Financing for Medicaid is shared by states & the federal government... **West Virginia receives \$4.5 billion in federal Medicaid funding**

Federal funding is **82%** of total Medicaid spending in West Virginia



In West Virginia, people **ages 65+** and **people with disabilities** are **24%** of Medicaid enrollees, but account for **53%** of spending

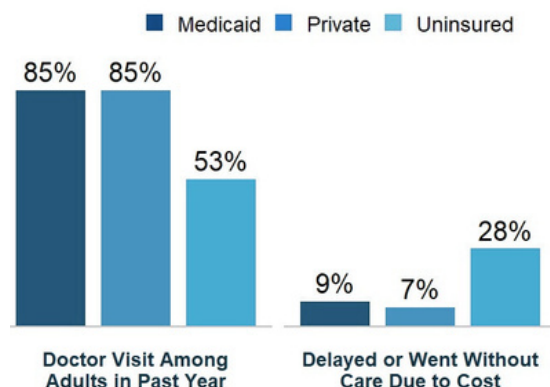


Per enrollee, **Medicaid spending is higher for** individuals receiving **institutional care**
